1: Develop intervention catalogue draft


Re-analysis of existing data regarding perceptions of mechanical restraint 2: Develop intervention catalogue

Systematic literature review of evidencebased interventions related to items in the intervention catalogue draft 3: Validate intervention catalogue


Focus group interviews with staff and relatives + single interviews with patients regarding items in the intervention catalogue
