Background:

Research show that 20 % of nurses are subject to workplace related violence or threats each year,
 and 67 % witness colleagues being assaulted or threatened by patients.
 Research on how staff report and describe situations regarding violence and threats seems sparse,
 as does research on correlations between frequency or type of violence or threat.

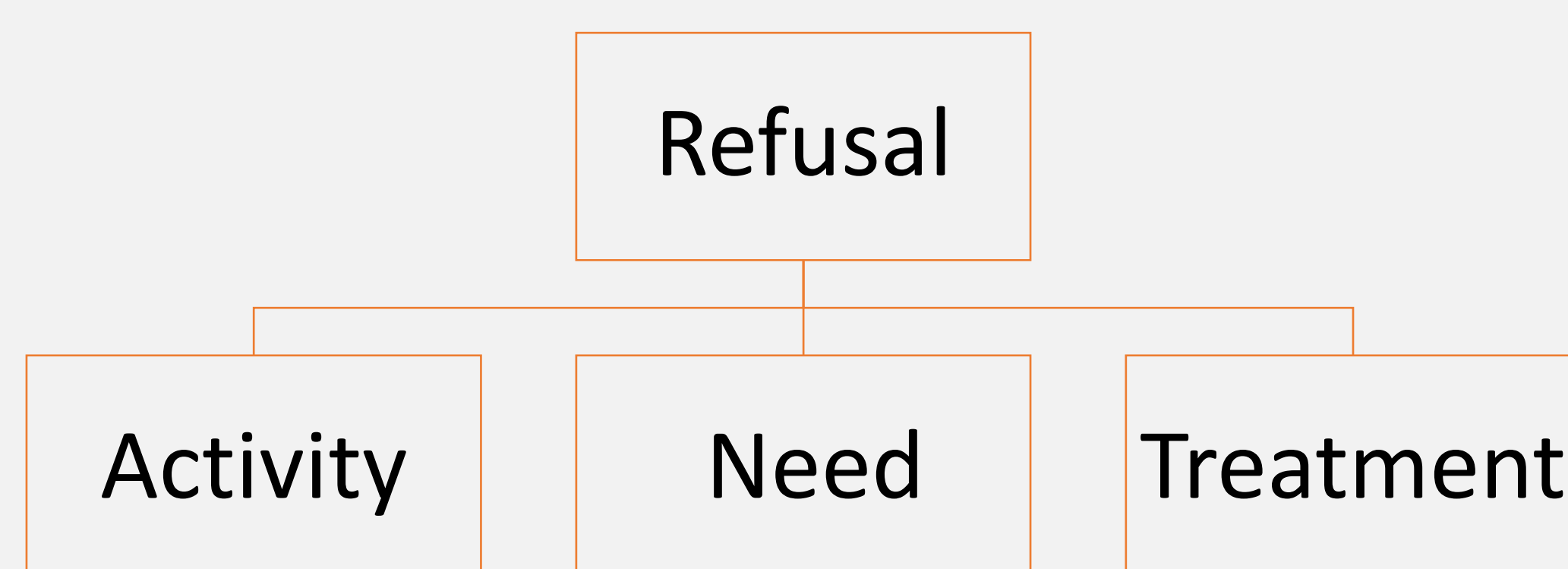
Aim:

To generate knowledge on how mental health staff report and describe situations of violence and
 threats along with statistical correlations between frequency and variables.

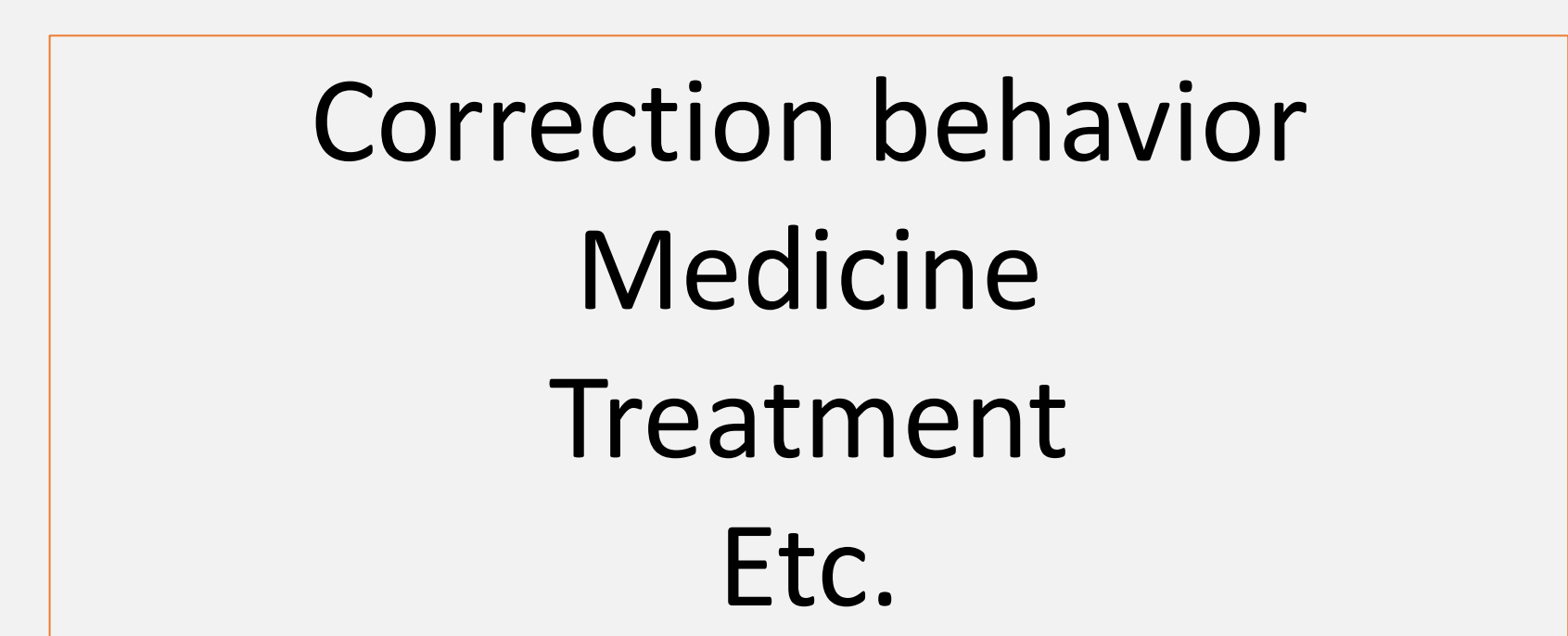
Preliminary results:

Data: 4.902 unique data base entries (staff reports on patient related violence) were coded

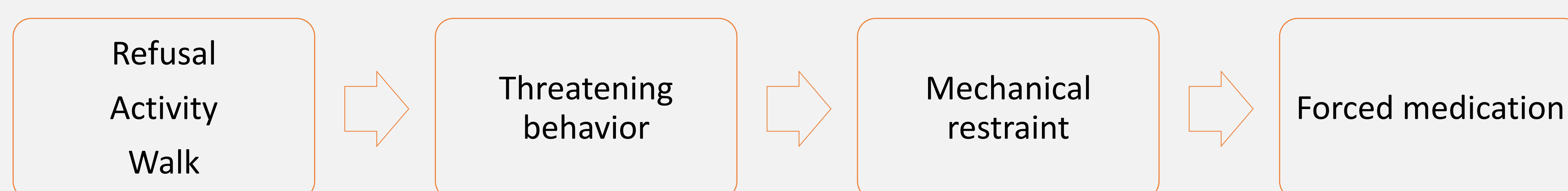
Example: Theme and subthemes
